**Opportunity name:** Member of the SCW Community Grants Committee

**What group is this opportunity helping:** The mission of SCW is to financially support individuals and organizations in the Greater Bay Area seeking to bring equality and justice into the lives of others, and to support UUSF in a manner that enhances the shared values of both organizations. With the recent bylaw changes, if you are a member of UUSF, you are also a member of the Society for Community Work.

**When is help needed (time frame) and what is the time commitment (hours per month/week/day):**

- The SCW Community Grants meets ~five times on Zoom from June to October. Committee members are also assigned 3 to 4 grant applications to review and make recommendations on. Time commitment is 2 to 4 hours a month between June and October. For 2023, the committee awarded \$62,500 by making 13 community grants ranging from \$500 to \$7000.

**What is the work to be done and where is the work to be done:**

- The SCW Community Grants meets ~five times on Zoom from June to October.

**Are there special skills and experiences that are required/helpful:**

- This is a great committee—you get to meet and give away money to organizations you believe in! Members both evaluate nonprofits grant applications and encourage other nonprofits to apply.
