

Resolution of Immediate Witness Regarding the New Federal Administration

Whereas, the incoming President and his appointees are announcing steps to carry out policies that are considered immoral by the First Unitarian Universalist Society of San Francisco; and

Whereas, these governmental actions and statements represent significant developments that necessitate immediate engagement and action,

Therefore, Let it be Resolved, the First Unitarian Universalist Society of San Francisco commits to continue advocating and working for values and causes that honor individuals regardless of race, ethnicity, sexual orientation or identity, immigration status, and physical ability; and

Let it be Resolved, our community specifically supports action and advocacy in these social justice areas:

- Supporting community members regardless of immigration status
- Supporting Transgender, Nonbinary, and Gender Nonconforming people, their rights, and their right to medical treatment
- Supporting Reproductive Rights
- Opposing the dismantling of the legal infrastructure in the United States that sustains and promotes the equality of persons of African descent
- Ending apartheid in Palestine while ending the war in Gaza, obtaining the return of the hostages, and ensuring the right of Israel to exist
- Working to promote democracy, anti-fascism, journalism, and combating misinformation
- Supporting people with disabilities and encouraging awareness of their issues
- Working to combat climate change
- Supporting and advocating for the unhoused, including doing Homelessness Street Level Learning and Advocacy with Faithful Fools
- Partnering with other UU Groups and Congregations
- Partnering with other groups working on our social justice concerns; and

Let it be Resolved that the Members of the First Unitarian Universalist Society of San Francisco acknowledge that the social justice priorities and issue focus will change as the Federal government's actions become clearer. We agree to maintain vigilance in community, to support each other, and to hold both social and cause-driven meetings in the future.
